Compulsory REVISION comments	The study presents an important theme because it deals with the knowledge, practices and attitudes of mothers about complementary feeding of their babies. The study carried out with a significant number of mothers, addresses exclusive breastfeeding, as well as emphasizes the importance of complementary feeding after six months of age. Although knowledge about complementary feeding was present in most mothers, the non-inclusion of food after six months of age still persists. The study clearly shows the importance of implementing health education strategies, with guidance to raise awareness among mothers. Therefore, it is of great importance for publication, as the dissemination of scientific knowledge is essential for the academic community and society in general, which will be able to benefit from the different orientations present in the research.	
Minor REVISION comments	The study is very significant because it brings important knowledge about the feeding of children from 6 to 24 months of age, emphasizing the importance of guiding mothers about exclusive breastfeeding up to 6 months, also bringing the need to guide mothers about Complementary feeding after 6 months, since, from this period onwards, physical and cognitive growth occurs quickly, it becomes essential to avoid the risk of malnutrition. The study favors the appropriation of this very significant knowledge, as it is relevant for publication, in this way the global society will be able to obtain relevant information on a topic as important as the feeding of children.	
Optional/General comments	The study addresses very important scientific knowledge, with robust research, clearly presenting the objectives and results obtained, therefore, I recommend the publication of the article.
