7. Missing reference in text "...The subtarsal incision.... of fracture site."
8. Insert reference 3 after "...for more exposure."
9. Insert reference after "... fat in retroseptal approach."
10. Insert author specification for Keen WW (Philadelphia WB Sanders 1909:1906-21.
11. Specify type of "complications" in sentence after reference 5

OBJECTIVE:

1. To unify the contents with the ABSTRACT by making the text clearer and more readable.

SUBJECT:

1. Replace with 'STUDY DESIGN'.

PARAMETERS:

1. Chapter not clear
2. Sentences are too long
3. Insert sub-chapters

DISCUSSION:

1. The chapter is not necessary in this type of article (pre-protocol or study protocol).
2. Check the references: sometimes are not correct
3. Specify the meaning of ZMC and ORIF
4. Put the references at the end of the sentence
5. Be more precise in the final part of the discussion and write shorter and clearer sentences.

CONCLUSION: not necessary
