<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	Please elaborate the results section and the discussion section; the Gantt chart is not required; the description of each kit for each analyte is redundant. It could be –for the sake of the readers- as additional data.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The overall idea behind the manuscript is good BUT the writing makes the reader really disappointed.
