What are mood disorders in this criterion refer to? Since mood disorder is a broad term that includes several diagnoses, e.g., major depressive disorder, bipolar disorder, dysthymia, and cyclothymia. The authors should clearly state the specific diagnoses.</li><li>2. Inclusion criteria "Either euthymic, remitted patients or patients having stable status for better co-operation in study." – The authors should describe the operational definitions of these terms (remitted patients, or stable status).</li><li>3. The third objective is "To establish any co-relation of cognitive dysfunction with metabolic syndrome in both the groups." – However, the authors did not clearly describe what diagnostic criteria for metabolic syndrome will be used, and how to collect this information (e.g., obesity, diabetes, or lipid profile).</li><li>4. Statistical analysis for each objective should be briefly described.</li></ol>
