Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The paper is a review of the use local anesthetics by epidural insertion and the effectiveness and safety of its uses is well discussed. The paper has several grammatical and typing mistake. In general sense it is not adjusted to journal format and they should correct the following mistakes:</p> <p>Title: The authors declared that effectiveness and safety of the uses of epidural insertion with local anesthetics and steroids is reviewed. But in the text the steroids is never mentioned. It is correct or your reference is opioids instead of steroids?</p> <p>Abstract: The first sentence is very long and hard to understand. I recommend to put a dot aftermajor surgeries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Methodology: Pubmet is Pubmed. - Review Findings: what it mean LA.? There are a lot of abbreviations in the text that should be described (LA; CVS, GIT, NMDA; CNS; CSF; and other). <p>INTRODUCTION: The first sentence is very long and hard to understand. I recommend to put a dot aftermajor surgeries.</p> <p>EFFICACY: There is a dot before 30 (efficacy/effectiveness.30 to 50%) In the text the numbers of the references is with [] and not with (). Also they should be put before the final dot of the sentences. This should be corrected in all the text. There are an abuse of the upper case in the mane of the medications of other (Local Anesthetics, Ropivacaine, Bupivacaine, Fentanyl, Alfentanyl, Sulfentanyl, etc.. these words should be written in lower case.) Sometime the abbreviation LA appears as LA, Las or Las (The most often used method is epidural infusions of LA-opioid combos epidural method,by the anesthesiologist in the world. Their usage is based on clinical evidence that combining LAs with opioids slows the progression of sensory block found with just Las(17)</p> <p>Homogenize the units (sometime is mcg/mL; other microgram/mL) Ropivacaine and 0.125% Bupivacaine mixed with fentanyl 0.2mcg/mi Is it correct?</p> <p>CNS Toxicity: The firt sentence has not any sense. I can understand this sentence.</p> <p>CHOICE OF DRUGS: 37.5–50 mg h⁻¹; compared with 0.2% Ropivacaine.And hemodynamic stability was more with ropivacaine as</p> <p>Hypotension: sensory and motor blockade, resulting in fall in blood pressureA significant drop in blood</p> <p>REFERENCES: The references should be fixed according to the journal format.
