On page 1, in the abstract, line 2, add comma before, such as In the introduction, paragraph 2, lines 1 and 2, state It is a virus, instead of It a virus On page 2, paragraph 1, line 2, use singular for generalized myalgia, instead of myalgias Line 4, micro biota can be divided, as well as in the rest of the manuscript Present Table 1 after its mentioning in the last sentence on this page</p> <p>On page 4, present Figure 1, Figure 2 and Table 2 after their mentioning in the second paragraph.
