<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>In this review, the authors report skin lesions seen in COVID-19 and their relationship to severity of disease. Although there are many reports and reviews on COVID-19 skin lesions, there are not so many reports from India, and it is commendable that this review includes India.</p> <p>However, there are many points that need to be pointed out.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Too many spelling mistakes.</li><li>2) There are numerous parts of English that are not correct.</li><li>3) Many of the words are colloquial rather than the wording used in writing.</li><li>4) It is not well organized. In general, the order is Introduction, Materials and methods, Results, and Discussion.</li><li>5) What is the structure of A:~. B:~. A:~ in the Discussion?</li><li>6) Summary appears in the Conclusion, and the structure is wrong.</li><li>7) Even though the title is Cutaneous manifestations of Covid-19 and mentions erythema and purpura in the text, it is difficult for the reader to understand what kind of skin manifestations occur. It would be better to present actual photos.</li><li>8) It is difficult to read and understand how much of each skin lesion may occur. It would be easier for the reader to understand and better review if you summarize the percentage of each skin lesion in the Tables.</li></ol> <p>At least the above points should be corrected or amended. I appreciate the fact that it deals with the subject of COVID-19, which is a worldwide epidemic, but it needs to be a better review based on the above points.</p>
