It must be updated.	
Minor REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Improve the keywords, they must be more specific.✓ Eliminate from table 4: cm and mmHg.✓ In discussion, the following abbreviations must be defined: ARI, ADR, ASACVD.✓ It could be argued that the high prevalence of hypertriglyceridemia could be due to a high consumption of carbohydrates. In Venezuela, a high prevalence of hypertriglyceridemia is also observed as a risk factor for metabolic syndrome.
