Compulsory REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All aspects of emergency care have been inadvertently affected due to the current pandemic with special considerations in the COVID-19 positive patient. This is clinically relevant and the authors should be commended on highlighting this. ➤ It would be useful if the authors could pay careful attention to the sentence structuring as it may risk losing the message the authors intend to highlight. ➤ Careful review with regards to the grammar used in the article would be advised ➤ 'According to a systemic review the odds ratio of transmission of infection by aerosol during airway manoeuvres like intubation is 6.6'- this is a reference that is nearly 10 years old, any new especially in the context of COVID-19? ➤ It would be useful to adhere to use medical terms and concepts ➤ The authors have well highlighted the infrastructure related limitation in healthcare that is not only unique to India, even in developed countries the resources are severely strained resulting in excess mortality. ➤ The use of dexamethasone in COVID-19 related pneumonitis versus the concern of the use of steroids in the septic patient- a topic that will garner much discussion. ➤ The anaesthetic perspective has been well described and documented- the authors should be commended on the same. ➤ It would be useful if images could be included within the article to further highlight the usefulness of the RA
