Compulsory REVISION comments	The manuscript addressed all the main topics relevant to the disease and it could be published. Need to provide more current references, with greater frequency in the text. "Introduction", 1 st paragraph: The phrase "...Diverticular disease occurs...diverticula" causes confusion. "Epidemiology", 1 st paragraph: "...inflammatory bowel symptoms..." has better be changed to "...symptoms reminiscent of inflammatory bowel disease..." "Evaluation", last paragraph: "...high fever..." instead of "...high/fever(greater than 39.2°C)..." "Management", last paragraph: Entire or most part better goes to "Etiology and pathophysiology."	
Minor REVISION comments	Need some grammatical revision. Abbreviations should all be explained once in timely order, if repeated in text.	
Optional/General comments	Add some study objectives in "Introduction". "Discussion" should be more comprehensive. Kind recommendation: My article "Perforated diverticulitis in a patient with very proximal jejuna diverticula". Journal of Gastric Surgery JGS 2020;2:102-105. DOI: 10.36159/jgs.v2i3.49
