In the method, a section concerning the type of study will specify this.</p> <p>In the abstract, the objective of the study was to evaluate the relationship between maternal diet and baby gender. However, in the methods "study design" the objective became: to determine the relationship between visual impairment and addiction to electronic devices use among Saudi, this is the suitable design for this research. The general objective of the study must remain constant, especially the one described in the abstract.</p> <p>In addition, the results presented did not show univariate and multivariate analyses done to suggest a probable association or link between diet and fetal sex. Your tables and figures are completely descriptive. You could have put tables with different univariate analyses and measures of associations.</p>
