Compulsory REVISION comments	To aim of the study was to assess the oral microbiota in two groups of participants: patients having oral malignancy and normal healthy individuals for comparison of the changes (tissue swab) for pre-treatment, post-treatment, and post-radiotherapy with the control group. However, no results of this study were not mentioned in this manuscript. The conclusion of this paper is without any results found and consequently, inadequate, inappropriate and not to be considered. The design of the study is not well defined, the processes of obtained specimens are not described and the editing language is very poor. The study must have ethical issues
