Alzheimer's disease is a neurodegenerative disease that slowly destroys memory and thinking skills. Parkinson's disease is a long-term degenerative disorder of the central nervous system that mainly affects the motor system. - "For various individuals' mental problems, such as Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease, depression, epilepsy, schizophrenia, anxiety, and others, herbal and Ayurvedic remedies are favored over synthetic medications."</li> <li>4. The Authors should organize the presentation of references in the manuscript text, as they are placed in superscript or only in parentheses.</li> <li>5.
