English correction is highly recommended -</p> <p>It is very difficult to read the paper with a lot of grammatical errors. extra space after punctuation, extra space after brackets are seen everywhere. So kindly give to some English teachers or someone good in English for basic correction.</p> <p>For example: the title of the paper - Depression among undergraduate medical student - it should be plural</p> <p>Aim : to look at the prevalence of depression on (among) medical students</p> <p>Methodology : We (The authors or researchers) looked at published researches (personal pronouns are generally avoided and they are replaced with author/s, researcher/s etc..) ... different areas</p> <p>10% of the student were having depression during the medical school</p> <p>Conclusion : due to high rate of depression among medical students , a coping strategies</p> <p>2. In the discussion part, the reasons for depression among medical students around the globe need to be discussed. They should be categorized and listed out. The present study only mentions that female students are more prone to depression but the reasons are not clearly stated. Study done in New Zealand also has higher female depression. So the author presumes that it is only in Asia. The discussion part is very important. Otherwise, this study is of no use.</p> <p>3. The conclusion is not properly written. Few scanty statements are written.</p> <p>4. References are not written properly. The author/s should follow the reference format as per the journal guidelines.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>In the literature review, if the country name is mentioned, the basic question that comes to the mind of every reader is - why only research done in few countries are selected. Therefore, in the beginning of literature review, it should be mentioned on what basis this study selected few researches.</p> <p>Do not mention the country name as caption.</p>	
Optional/General comments	<p>1. The paper should be corrected for English language.</p> <p>2. Research format should be followed.</p> <p>3. The paper looks like a classroom assignment submission. Need some research style and touch.</p>
