Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>Great effort was seen in writing the article which is quite commendable. However, the following observations were made:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The objective of the article is not clearly stated in the abstract but was buried in between the article. This is very important because it will guide the reader at what result to look out for.2. Though the intervention introduced during the research was clearly stated and the number of subjects used for the research, it wasn't clearly written the outcome of such intervention.3. The discussion of the findings for the article did not clearly state if the outcome (findings) of this article is supported by any previous studies or otherwise, though, book review was written but there was no link between the current study and the previous studies.4. The ethical process followed for the study is not stated. This is very important as it involved intervention on children.	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>There is a need for proof reading of the entire article for some minor typographical errors and rearrangement of some parts of the article. For instance, bullet points under the sub-unit of "complications" need to be re-arranged properly.</p>
