<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The FTIR, XRD section basically figure needs to be represented with peaks also as in the present form it does not give clear image of the interpretation.</li> <li>2. The DSC curve should also represent the details about physical mixture of the APIs along with the starch and its modified forms as the present representation does not explain about compatibility of the API with the excipient systems.</li> <li>3. The SEM images G and H does not resemble each other with different magnification. In G the surface is smooth and rough only on one side while higher magnification of the same in H is completely rough kindly attach a note about the same in R and D section.</li> <li>4. In the section of %EE brief out the details about how drug loading was calculated and the ratio was optimised.</li> <li>5. In drug release section and kinetics of release study there is no clear explanation about the release mechanism of the APIs from the system incorporate the same in details.</li> <li>6. Check spellings of all headings and grammar of the text it needs through consideration.</li> </ol>
