Compulsory REVISION comments	How big is the population of children who are cared for by the clinic? There is a mistake in patient numbers: In the abstract 35 of 67 patients have MIS-C. In table 1 only 33 patients are listed (2 died?). So far I understand only patients are included who had positive PCR or antibodies. However, even more children would have COVID-19 exposure within the 4 weeks prior to onset and probably some of the 32 patients who are excluded had MIS-C but no PCR or antibodies. Please declare the diagnosis of the 32 children who are excluded from analysis. Did they have Kawasaki Disease?	
Minor REVISION comments		
Optional/General comments	Well written paper with a high clinical impact. However, I miss some data to the incidence and there is a risk that some patients are misdiagnosed not to have MIS-C.
