The author found that miR-1301-3p as an elevated miRNA in lung cancer via analyzing previous published microarray data. Overall, this review is well formatted and written. My only suggestion is that in the Abstract, the authors mentioned "epidemiological evidence suggests that glyphosate use on crops is linked to a wide range of cancers, including liver cancer, breast cancer, thyroid cancer, pancreatic cancer, kidney cancer, bladder cancer, and myeloid cancer.". However in the main text, the role of glyphosate was only discussed in liver cancer, adipose cancer, breast cancer, prostate cancer, thyroid cancer and Non-Hodgkin lymphoma. Please further discuss the role of glyphosate in pancreatic cancer, kidney cancer, bladder cancer. As the most common human cancer type, lung cancer, whether glyphosate has any effect on the development of lung cancer?</p>
