Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The statistical analysis (chi square test) used to determine variation between the numbers of DTP observed in the 2 phases of data collection is not appropriate. A t test would have been more suitable.</p> <p>The method does not indicate clearly how DTP were classified.</p> <p>The introduction section was not well arranged and most statements lacked references. This section should be re-written. Author should do more literature review to add on appropriate references.</p> <p>The method section should state clearly whether OPD or inpatient folders were used or both.</p> <p>Results: The 97 total errors seen in the first phase is different from the 77 error mentioned earlier.</p> <p>The same inconsistency is observed in the result for errors in the second phase. Explain this.</p> <p>Discussion: Several statements here also do not have references and there are sentences which are not complete.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>There are some grammatical errors which require corrections.</p> <p>Calculation of sample size required margin of error. This was not stated.</p> <p>Amoxicillin+Clavulanic acid : This is not enhanced beta lactamase. Its penicillin with beta lactamase inhibitor combination. Correct this.</p>
