<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<b>The paper needs English revision.</b> <b>The methodology must be better described and the origin of the ethanolic extract of the plant must be defined. If the own authors produced the extract, they must give some information about the plants (where they grow, which part was used, the weigh, the form of the part used) and the procedure to get the extract.</b> <b>The statistical test does not inform how the normality of the sample was accessed.</b> <b>The tables and figures in the results section needs a brief text to introduce it and to explain why you are showing them. The result section must not have just tables and figures. Review the measurements units in some tables.</b>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	The subtitle of tables and figures does not fit in the rules of the journal. In the same way, the results section does not fit in the rules of the journal.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	I prefer graphs and figures to show the results in some cases. But you can choose what is better for your paper. However, take care to not repeat the same information in more than one table or graph. Each one must have an aim in your paper for further discussion.
