If there is official statistic data in regard with the number of deaf and hard of hearing people and the number of dentists practicing in Pakistan, it should be included as part of the introduction. 2. Many efforts are being made in the contemporary world to improve the quality of life of deaf and hard of hearing people. In this regard, it is necessary to differentiate the two-way communication between the dentist and the deaf and hard of hearing patients. There are still no suitable software to support sign language translation into speech or text, but there are many good practices that use speech-to-text translation to help the dentist present clear and correct information to his deaf patients. I recommend presenting some of these practices in the introductory part or in discussing the results of the study. 3. It is necessary to write author's recommendations (preferably in the concluding part) to public health authorities how to support the deaf and hard of hearing patients in the process of receiving dental care services. 	
Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The language in the article is clear and correct. However, the formatting of the text needs to be adjusted – there too many extra spaces and in other part of the article where a space is required, such as after comma or semicolon, such a space is missing. 2. Additionally, the author of the article is kindly requested to review the second sentence of the second paragraph of the Introduction, namely "While the language and the punctuation of the sentence can be different to support execution and familiarity with talking." due to the fact that it sounds as not completed.
