Please shed some light on the consequences of electrolytes imbalances and the importance of knowing the status of electrolytes in this babies.</p> <p>There are some discrepancies in the level of Na and K in different studies. Please discuss some possible underlying causes/explanation of the findings and changes in the management of the cases accordingly to make the discussion part meaningful.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>It is not clear why the children below 2 months were not included in this study.</p> <p>Lots of careless mistakes. Please correct the grammar, verbs and use proper singular/plural throughout the article.</p> <p>Avoid the repetition of 'total 246 children were included in this study' in the methodology.</p> <p>'Prelacteal food' is not clear. Please give a brief introduction before elaborating on the topic.</p> <p>Please edit the last line of conclusion.</p> <p>Please include the year of publication of ref 25.</p>
