How many underwent Radiology, FNAC and Surgical resection. Need some clarity. Socio demographic details are not explained in depth. Only gender list you mentioned. It would be appropriate with region specific and iodine deficiency areas. Explain the reason to exclude cases with deranged thyroid hormones.
