Compulsory REVISION comments	The study deals with an interesting area, worthy of being researched. However, the article lacks clarity and readability. The research article is poor in linguistic style and has much difficulty to convey the message to the academic audience. Plenty of grammatical errors have been noted which require correction. The study involved the use of participants with three different types of cancer, namely, breast, lung and gastric cancer. However, all the three types of cancer patients were included in a singly study group, thereby inviting heterogeneity in the sample. The method adopted in the study appears to be lacking much scientific rigour. Table heads are vague. APA referencing style has also not been uniformly used. Some references are also incomplete. The article may be published after major revision.
