The names of ethics committee giving your approvals should be mentioned precisely and they should be acceptably official ones.2. Since you used different equipments and methods to analyze blood chemicals of animals and that of humans, you could not compare their results as you presented the Figure 4.3. Why did you choose only female human subjects but only male rats?4. The human volunteers were not a diabetic patient, what do your results indicate the effect of AJWA? And how much was the amount of AJWA in each drink? Is this amount commonly ingested in your region?5. Your graphic results are really difficult to watch unless they are enlarged to a full page per figure. They should be tabulated instead.
