The literature review is comprehensive and authors managed to successfully discuss the importance of their research, from both a theoretical and an applied perspective. Authors do a good reference to the theoretical fundament for their research work. The methods they choose are adequate, sampling method and sample size are appropriate. The results presented in this work pointed to the promising effects of compounds isolated from <i>Achyranthes aspera</i> (IAA) and <i>Amaranthus spinosus</i> (IAS) may possess promising potential for augmenting the immune activity by cellular and humoral mediated mechanisms at dose of (5 mg/kg) as a an alternative therapeutic way to augment the potential of the humoral immune system. More experimental works are needed in the future for more clarification and elucidation the beneficial effects of these medicinal plants.
