<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>It is interesting novel which the author has chosen. However, unless you read the novel and familiar with the plot of the novel you will not understand the personality analysis done by the author.</p> <p>1. In the introduction part, the Basic Plot Summary of the novel, a brief background information about the author of the novel, the main characters in the novel should be presented. Otherwise, no one knows what the novel talks about, what are the characters appear in the novel etc. Since the novel is written in Indonesian language and no English translation is available (as far I know, no English review is available etc) and the journal audience is from all over the world, it is very difficult to understand the journal article.</p> <p>2. The title of the paper says, THE PERSONALITY OF THE CHARACTERS... but the paper talks about only one character Jagat.</p> <p>3. A background information of Jagat, his age, marital status, his relationship with wife, the new lady he met at Seoul -Myung Heein, is not given in the paper and therefore the readers of this paper will find it very hard to understand the personality analysis done by the author pf the paper. The author has focused only on Jagat as a migrant worker from Indonesia in Seoul, but when we analyze the personality, we need to take into consideration many personal factors of the individual.</p> <p>4. The personality analysis is mainly done on the basis of Freudian Psychoanalysis as it mentions about id, ego and super ego. But the author mentioned in the beginning that personality analysis is based on Sigmund Freud, Gordon W. Allport, Gerald Heymans, and Abraham Maslow. The author can strictly stick with one psychologist for analyzing the personality of Jagat. Maslow, has a different psychology than Freud and I don't know how the author combined psychoanalysis with Maslow psychology</p>
