Kindly add methods, Results, and Conclusion to the abstract</li> <li>4. It is better put as "Introduction" than "Introduction and Context"</li> <li>5. Correct this "one of such is Adeoti and Osotimehin (2012) [3]". It is better stated as "one of such is [3]"</li> <li>6. Try to be consistent in your citations. Kindly adjust these "Reynolds (2015, p 199)"; "the study by Khan et al. (2017)"; "by Chou et al.(2005)"; "Willcock and Feeny (2006)"; "(Reynolds 2015, p 138)"</li> <li>7. Consider these two statements "This study is centered on the survival of an organization due to the operation and Management of its e-business" and "this study makes Covenant University school fees e-payment as a case study and discussed in section 3." Do they have anything in common?</li> <li>8. I suggest this title "Covenant University e-payment Challenges: The Genesis and Remedies to the problem"</li> <li>9. You need to get data collected from the beneficiaries or donors so that it will not be based on your personal opinions only</li> <li>10. You need to get permission from the University management on this aspect because it may be implicative at the end. Kindly check educational law that attached to this before going further</li> </ol>
