Compulsory REVISION comments	Microbial load figures must be written with superscripts and not subscripts(abstract) Typing should be done without omission of some words, as this takes the communication out of context (line 1 of introduction). Temperature figure should have superscripts and not otherwise (second to last line of materials and methods). The reference list did not conform to the Vancouver style- very poor. Wrong abbreviation of initials, wrong use of periods and commas, no use of standard journal abbreviations, poor use of semicolons, wrong page numbering etc.
