It would have been appropriate to show a picture of the eggs to inform health professionals what they should be looking out for. Instead, they show the head and tail of adult worm, and have no reference for it. The reference to Fig 1 is essential.</p> <p>-The treatment and follow up of this case could be added so health professionals are well informed of what to do with such a case</p> <p>-The grammar and tenses could be better. “.... request her to come tomorrow in lab with his son...” there are phrases like this which should be correctly written</p> <p>-Important to specify area where this was found</p>
